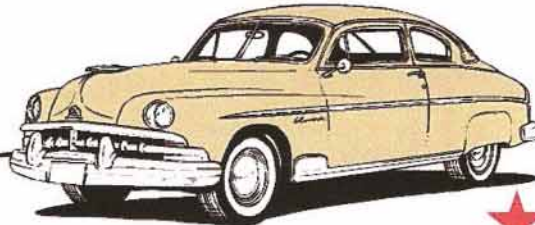

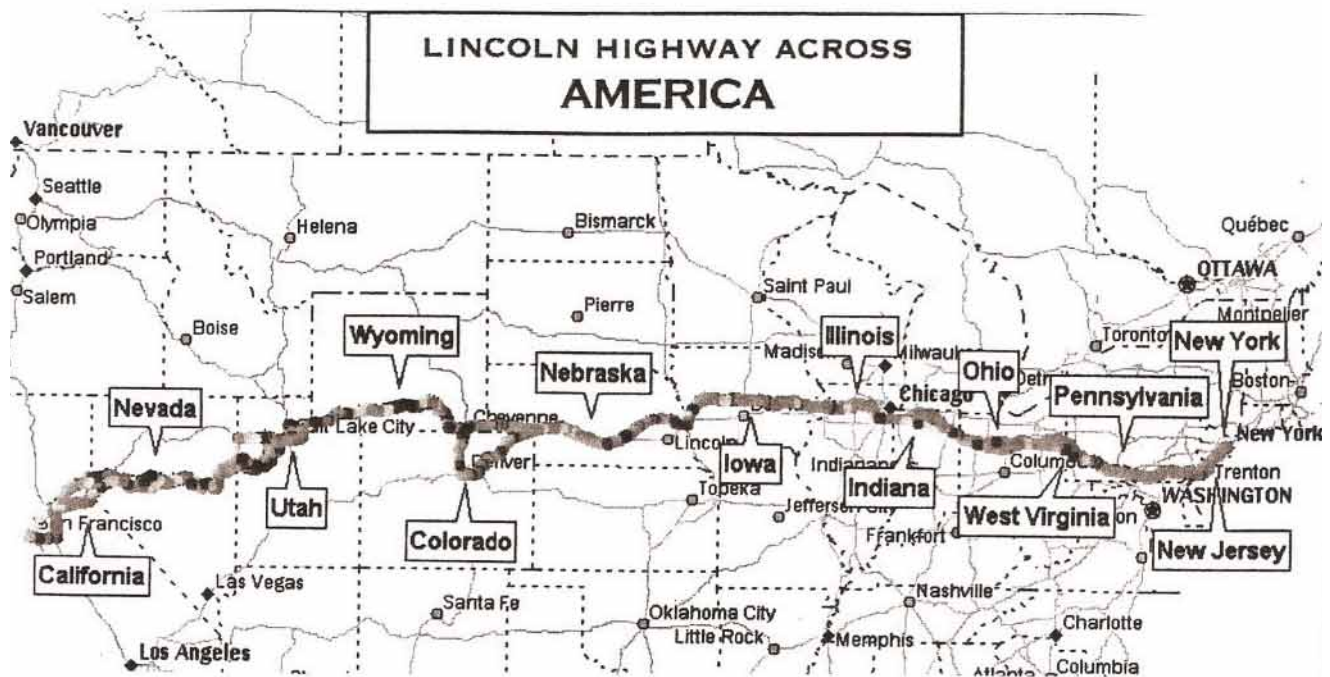

LINCOLN'S CARAVAN ON LINCOLN HIGHWAY



The Midwest Region invites you to join them on the Lincoln Highway Caravan, Sunday September 19 and Monday September 20, 2010. We have two caravans, one going west across Nebraska and the other traveling east across Iowa and Illinois. You are welcome to leave the caravan whenever your travel plans require you to do so.

Jack Fletcher will lead the caravan traveling east and Brian Gardner and Dan Brown will lead the westward caravan. The trip will include landmarks and Historical sites along this famous highway!.

The caravans will depart from Grisanti's Casual Italian Restaurant on West Dodge in Omaha (Original Lincoln Highway) and travel westward on West Dodge to 180th where we will turn north to a three mile stretch of the original brick roadway in Elkhorn, Nebraska. This will give us the opportunity to photograph the entire caravan on the Lincoln Highway before the caravans split and travel east across Iowa and west across Nebraska.

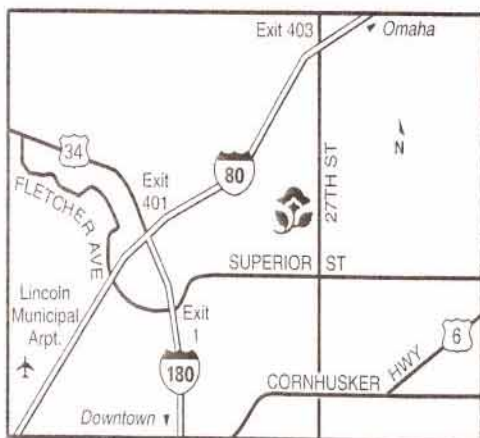

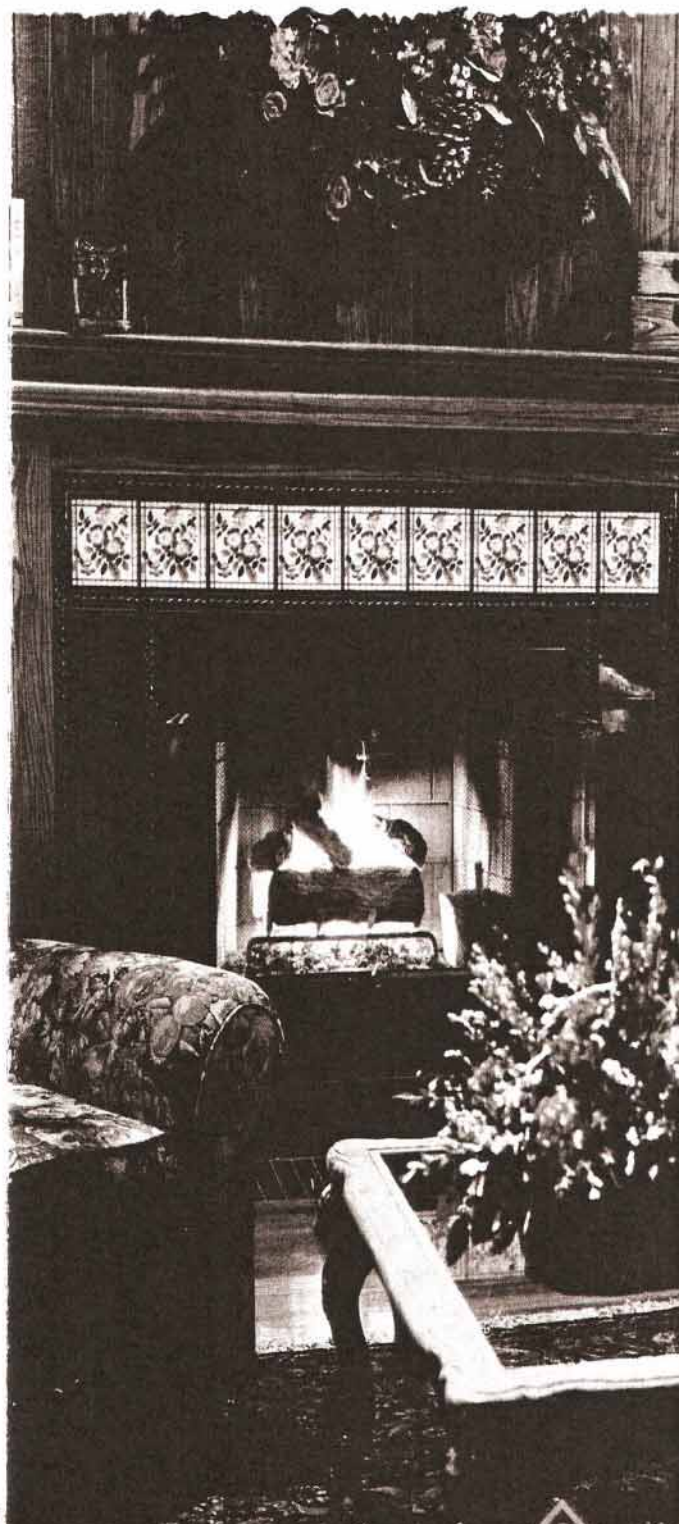
