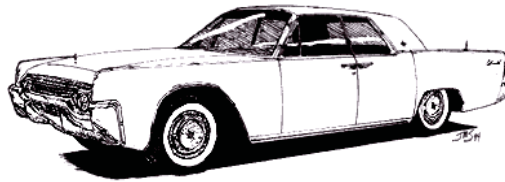

LCOC January 23, 2010 Board Meeting

Jerry Flanary and Darren Klingler at National Directors attended the recent LCOC board meeting in January. Jerry held the proxy for Gary Stapleton as Regional Director. Our meeting was in Orlando, Florida – it was definitely warmer than Indiana but cloudy just about every day!

The national and world economic conditions have hit us all, including our Club. The biggest issue is LCOC membership has gone down – putting a strain on LCOC's budget. So, renew your LCOC membership and refer prospective members to www.lcoc.org for membership application. Speaking of web site, check it out for details on plans for 2010, 2011, and 2012 national meets and to request meet registrations. You may have noticed the paper in Comments being different, this was a cost savings measure (among others) that saved a lot of dollars and was the main reason we did not have a deficit ending budget for 2009. The board made Doug Mattix (former LCOC President and current National Director) director-emeritus after his current term ends.

If you are interested in getting involved with LCOC management, consider running for a national board seat – filing is due by June 1st to Carol Mattix (Elections Clerk). Many judging issues were discussed and acted upon. Long time Judging Standards Committee Chair recently resigned; he was replaced with Steve D'Ambrosia – look for details in future edition of *Comments*. On a related note, the Exhibition registration fee at meets has been reduced to \$20 (from \$35) and those in Exhibition will now be able to have their Lincoln informally judged – this will help first time car showers.

Over all, this meeting and the two days of committee meetings prior were very productive. Thanks to Glenn Kramer and Art Whitmire's leadership in making the meeting one of the best in years.

Plans for the next January board meeting is for New Orleans – any member is welcomed to attend. The next board meeting will be in Lincoln, Nebraska on September 17, 2010 during the Midwest Region's presentation of the MidAmerican National Meet. LCOC 2010 Lincoln Foundation Museum Funding Campaign

February, 2010

Dear Hoosier Region Member,

The LCOC was one of the leaders in getting the Lincoln Motor Car Foundation established. Now we need your help in building the Foundation's Lincoln Motor Car Museum. There have been numerous articles published in the Foundation's publication, *Lincoln Link* and our magazine *Lincoln and Continental Comments* on plans to build the museum on the Gilmore Car Museum's Hickory Corners, Michigan campus. Our museum will join other great clubs, Classic Car Club of America, Pierce Arrow Club, Franklin Club, Cadillac-LaSalle Club and Model A Ford Club on this world class campus. We're sure you agree it's important that we preserve the heritage of our great Lincoln's for future generations to enjoy.

Many members of the four Lincoln clubs have been working for years to bring this idea to a reality. In order to jump start the effort, Jerry Capizzi and Chris Dunn have graciously presented us with matching grants totaling \$300,000. These grants only apply when we match the \$300,000 with other donations by August 1, 2010. We're happy to tell you that over 33% of the required matching funds have already been pledged, but the clock is ticking on the August 1st matching funds andWE NEED YOUR HELP!

Now is the time for our LCOC members to step up to the challenge. The matching funds make your immediate participation in this project twice as important. Every dollar you give means two dollars for the museum fund. You can make an *immediate pledge* or a *long term pledge* payable over five years. Your pledge is tax deductible. Gifts can be made in your name, a memorial or in the name of someone that you would like to honor. There are several different levels of pledges:

Make a *5 year pledge* of \$200 per year or *immediate donation* of \$1,000 or more and you'll receive a lifetime Lincoln Motor Car Foundation membership in addition to helping meet the matching challenge.

You can select a named Walkway Brick by making an *immediate donation* of \$100 or you can choose to make a *5 year pledge* of \$100 per year for a \$500 named Patio Paver.

You may also name a garden with an *immediate donation* of \$5,000 or make a \$5,000 per year *5 year pledge* and name an exhibit. Galleries are available with a *5 year pledge* of \$10,000 per year. Special naming opportunities are also available.

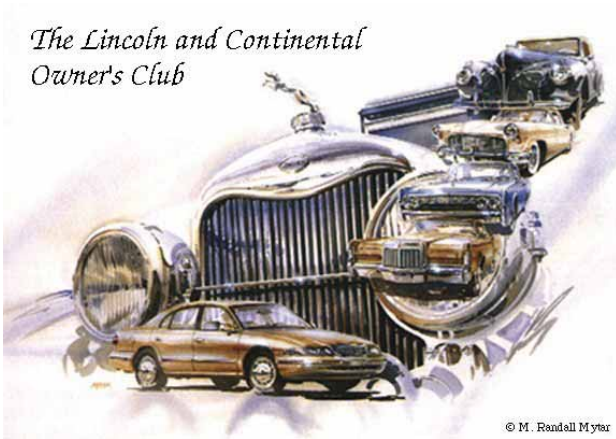
