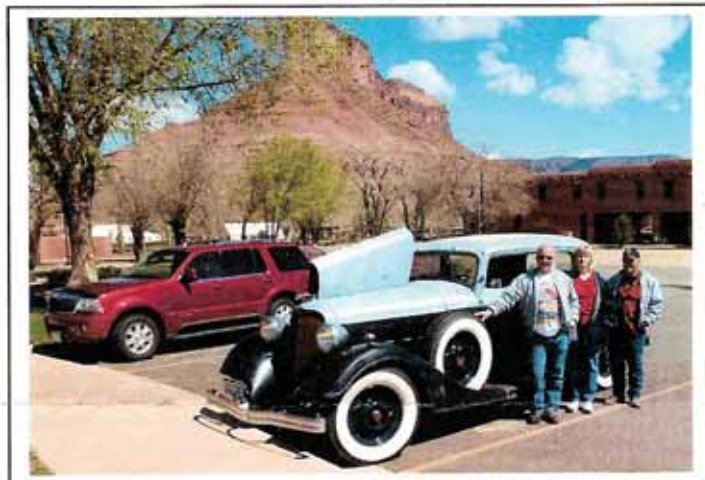


Our April Event to the Gateway, Colorado Auto Museum

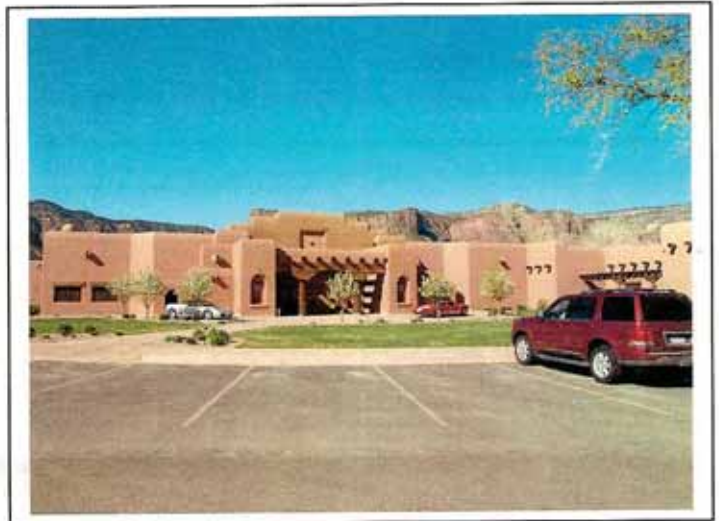


John Hendricks' Car Collection - Gateway, Colorado

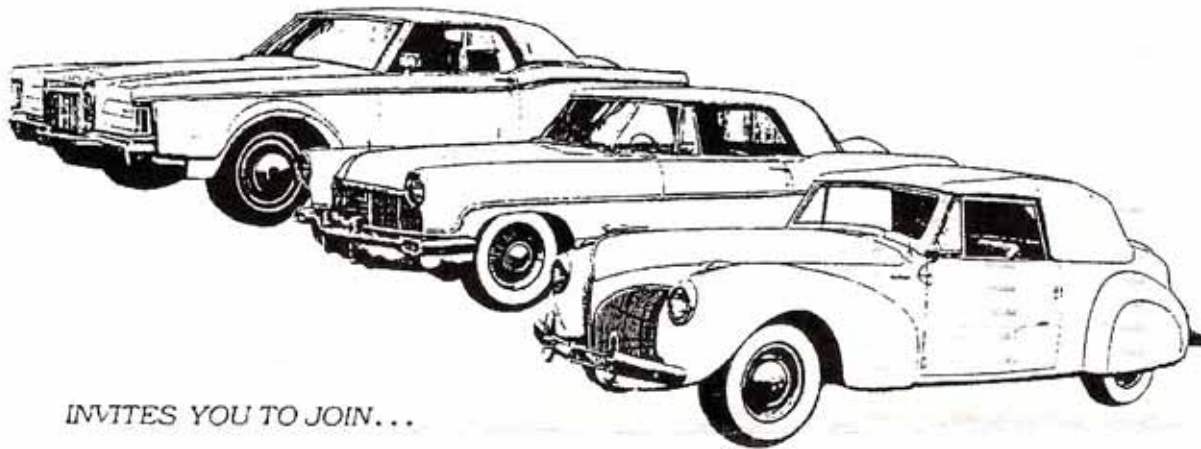
