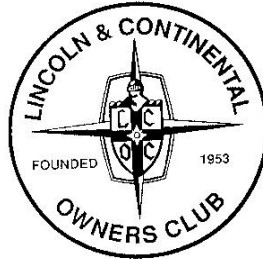

2011 CLASSIC AUTO PARADE OF THE YEARS

2011 will celebrate the 26 annual running of the Classic Auto Parade of the Years sponsored by the Estes Park Car Club. The event commemorates the opening of Estes Park to Spring and Summer visitors, and the importance of the automobile in the development of tourism around Rocky mountain national Park. This year the event will be held on May 21st and 22nd.

Starting on Saturday the 21st at 8:00 AM in the parking lot of the Loveland Reporter-Herald, 201 East 5th Street, Loveland CO. Breakfast will be provided in Loveland to all registered for the event, and the vehicles will be "on show" until about 10: AM. The tour will then start and progress up Hwy 34 to Drake where we will stop for a tailgate lunch (bring your own) and a "show" until about 2:00 PM. The tour will then continue to Estes Park, stopping at the Stanley Museum in lower Stanley Village, across from the Estes Park Visitor's Center for a tour of this interesting collection of Stanley Family artifacts. Displays include a Stanley Steamer with demonstration models showing how the Steamer works. We thank the Stanley Museum for opening especially for the Parade of Years Tour.

Following the Museum tour there will be free time for folks to wander thru town, check-in the lodging or otherwise enjoy the Estes Park area.

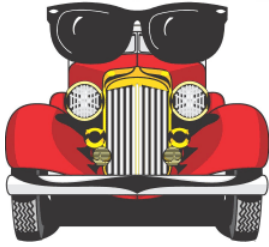
We have a special room rate at the Rodeway Inn in Estes for those wanting to stay over night. The rate is \$59.95 for the night of May 21st. Call 1-800-458-1182 and ask for the POY (Parade of the Years) room special. To guarantee a room at this rate, reservations must be made by May 6, 2011.

At 5:50 PM we will gather for a happy hour, banquet, and more time to visit with "car friends". There will be a program following dinner, and all attending will have a chance for door prizes. This will conclude Saturdays activities.

On Sunday, the 22nd at 9:00 AM we will meet to display the vehicles around Bond Park in Downtown Estes Park. Breakfast will be provided in the Women's Club room in the Municipal Building across from Bond Park. Near the conclusion of the show, we will elect the Peoples Choice Winners for the pre 1950 and post 1950 vehicles. The show will end at about 1:00 PM leaving time to enjoy the town and the National Park..

Spectators are admitted free to all shows.

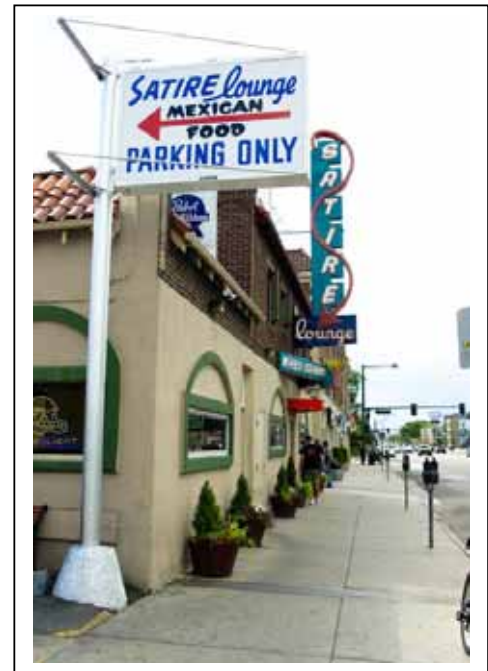


Our June RMR - LCOC Event - Denver Museum of Miniatures, Dolls and Toys

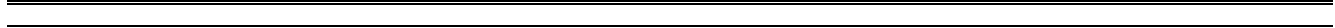


Recap of Our March RMR - LCOC Event - The Wild Animal Sanctuary

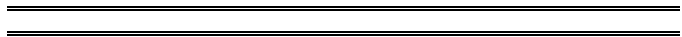

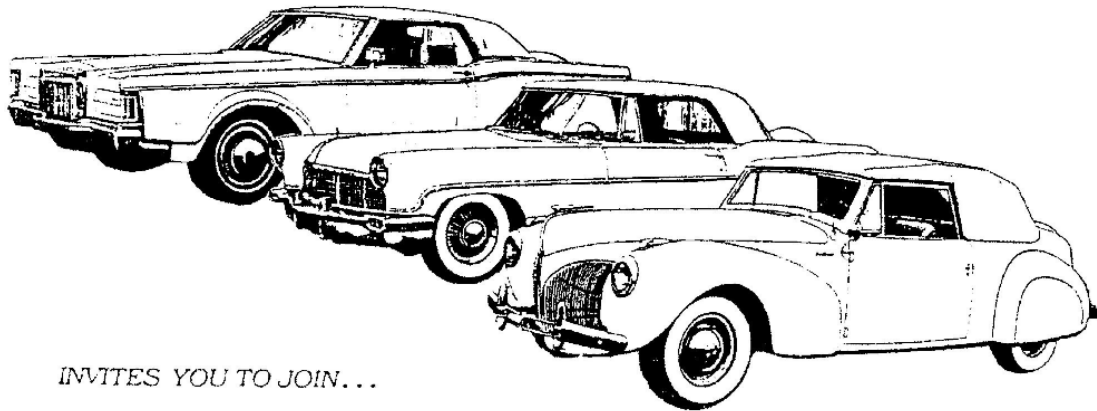
