Date: December 10, 2011 at Noon.

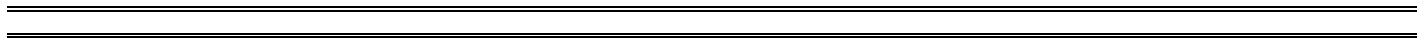

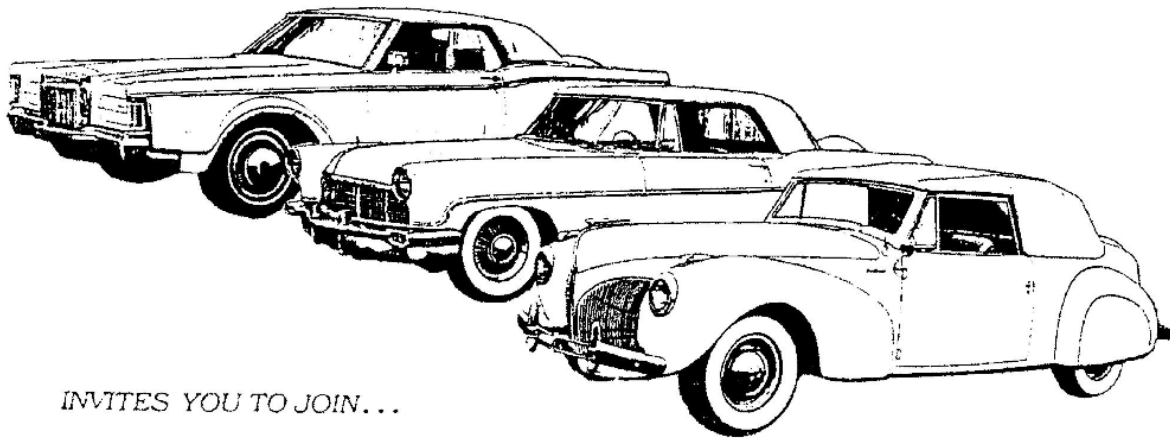
### From the Trivia Department

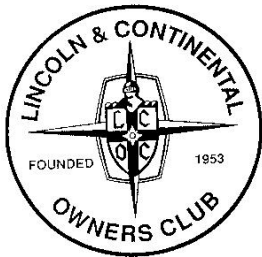
