Here are some photos from past events.

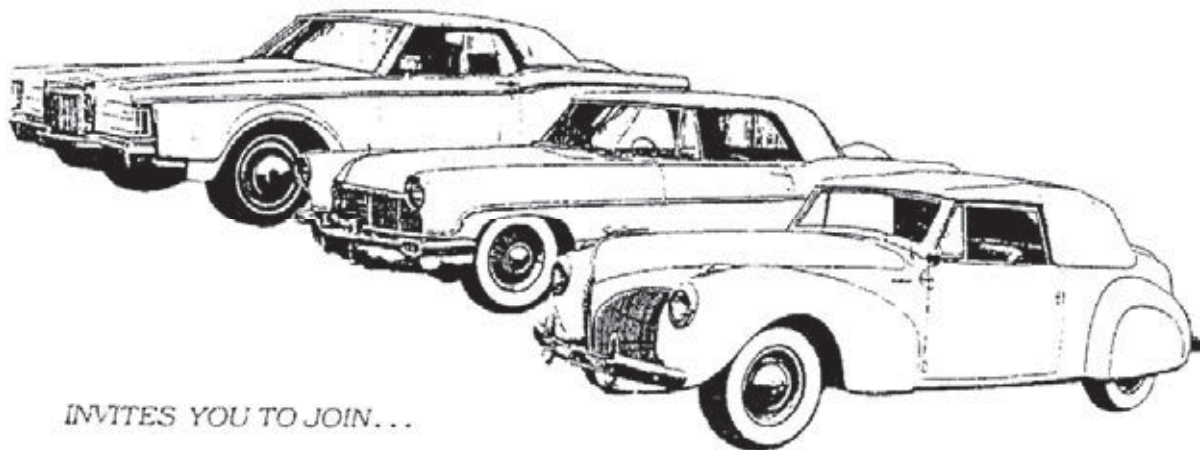
